Application for DoD MOU

The revision to the Department of Defense Instruction (DoDI) 1322.25, "Voluntary Education Programs," includes an appendix containing the DoD Voluntary Education Partnership Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between DoD Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness (USD(P&R)) and educational institutions. DoD policy requires educational institutions that wish to participate in the DoD Tuition Assistance (TA) Program to sign an MOU conveying the commitments and agreements between the educational institution and DoD prior to an educational institution receiving funds from a service's TA program. 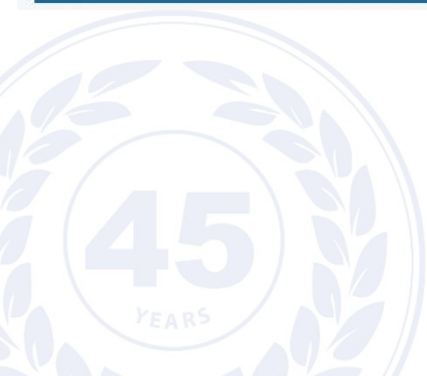

Military Training Evaluation Program (MTEP)

Overview

The Military Training Evaluation Program helps service members earn college credit recommendations for knowledge gained through military training and occupational experiences. These college credit recommendations reduce the number of classes a service member needs to satisfy degree requirements, thus saving time and money and avoiding Tuition Assistance (TA) costs. These credit recommendations are documented on the Joint Services Transcript (JST).

MTEP Process Overview

American Council on Education (ACE) Contract

- Improve DoD's capacity to evaluate, document, and communicate college level learning from military training courses and on-the-job experiences that is widely accepted

ACE Evaluation of Military Training

- Virtual and onsite academic military training course and occupational experience reviews using multidisciplinary postsecondary faculty teams
- ~440 training courses (~108,000 academic hours) and 60 occupations reviewed each year

Evaluation Output Documentation

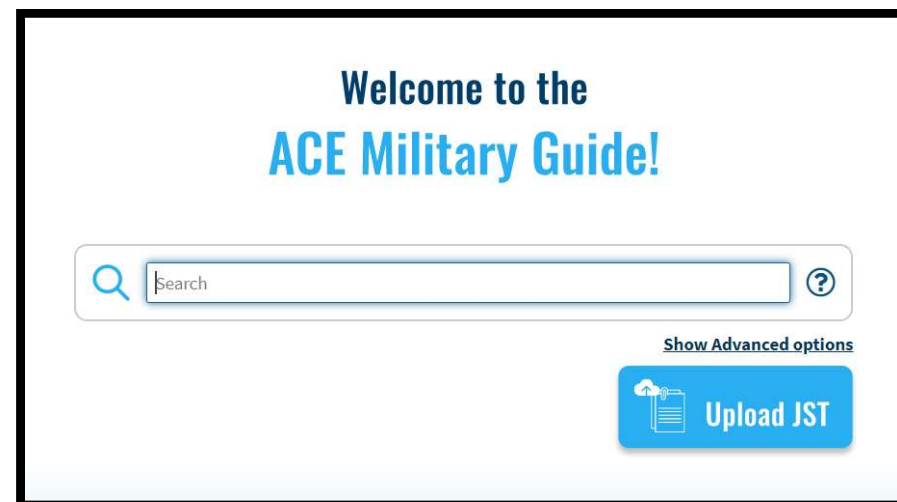
- Output of each evaluation is stored within the ACE Military Guide
- Sole source of info for all military courses and occupations evaluated by ACE from 1954 to present
- Credit recommendations maintain a ten-year shelf life

Service Member/Veteran JST

- Learning translated into college credit recommendations documented on the JST satisfy vocational through graduate level postsecondary degree requirements
- Reduces time to degree and college/TA cost
- Increases self-efficacy that supports continued persistence

The modernized ACE Military Guide: April 1, 2021

- Re-imagined search and information display experience
- Automated JST upload and exhibit retrieval
- Suite of dedicated tools for academic institutions to support their work of evaluating military learning for credit



A better user experience for academic institutions leads to more degree-generating credit awarded to SMs and Veterans *plus* an automated, built-in feedback mechanism for DANTES and the Services to analyze the actual credit awarded based on ACE's recommendations





MMG Registrant Data – Get on Board!

Academic Institutions enthusiastic about supporting military-connected learners – over 850 have requested accounts and begun the Onboarding process!

- Nationwide coverage
- 858 Schools have registered for MMG accounts
- 761 (89%) registered are DoD MOU schools
- 23 of 25 top Tuition Assistance receiving schools are participating in the program
